The Year 3 team will be helping your child to develop the skills they need to be independent and happy learners as they start Key Stage 2 at Boothville Primary School.





PE Kil

We have two PE sessions per week, on Monday and Wednesday. We also have physical activities on other days so it is a good idea to have your PE kit in school all week. Please make sure you have the correct kit with you. For indoor PE, boys and girls will wear plain black or blue shorts and a house t-shirt. For outdoor PE, warm tracksuit bottoms, house t-shirt and trainers. Please write your child's name and class on each item. You can buy new House t-shirts from the office. If you wear earrings you must be able to take them out and put them back in by yourself. If you are getting your ears pierced please do this at the start of the summer holidays. Long hair must be tied back for PE lessons.

Homework and Reading

We will be sending a Homework book and a Reading diary home during the first few weeks of term. We will start the year with a termly homework grid. We will also ask you to practise spellings and times tables every week. We would like everyone to read for 10-15 minutes every day. More information will be provided at the beginning of term about the Accelerated Reader scheme and quizzes we use in KS2.

Roulines

Morning: In the morning, the class doors will be unlocked at 8:40am.

3BG will enter through the Middle room door.

3BL & 3MG will enter through the back door of the Year 3 area.

At the end of the day: We will take you outside to meet whoever is collecting you at 3.30pm.

3BG will leave from the Middle room door for the children to be collected.

3BL will line up next to the front entrance gate to be collected.

3MG will line up in front of the 3MG classroom windows, in the middle area to be collected.

Playtime Snacks and Water Bottles

You can bring in a healthy snack from home to have at morning break Make sure you bring your named water bottle with you every day. This should be taken home at the end of each day and brought back full of water every morning. Bottles can be bought from the office or you can bring your own named water bottle.

<u>Lunches</u>

In Year 3 all children must have their lunches pre-ordered and paid for using the Parent App. More information will be provided about this by the school office but the children will have a choice of hot dinners, sandwiches or salad boxes. Otherwise you need to provide a packed lunch for your child.

Forest School

Children in Year 3 will have Forest School sessions throughout the year on a Tuesday. More information will be provided but all children will need weather appropriate clothing and wellies or an old pair of shoes to take part in these sessions.

Equipment

We will provide pens and pencils so there is no need to bring in your own pencil cases. Please ensure all clothing, resources and equipment you send into school is clearly labelled with your child's name and class.
